MADIKWE GAME<u>R</u>ESERVE

Madikwe Game Reserve is South Africa's 5th largest game reserve and also one of its best kept secrets. This hidden-gem is regarded as one of the best conservation areas in Africa and offers over 75,000 hectares of pure African wilderness. The park hosts a number of luxurious lodges as well as community lodges.

Madikwe Game Reserve is situated in the malaria free North West Province, bordering Botswana. In addition to lion, leopard, elephant, rhino or buffalo, this *Big Five* reserve is renowned for its wild dog reintroduction as well as the unusual gemsbok, tsessebe and springbok. The lions in Madikwe originate from Etosha in Namibia and are known to hunt very large prey such as giraffe and eland.

In 1991 the area was declared a reserve and 10,000 mammals were relocated from other National Parks. The park is home to approximately 66 large mammals and roughly 300 bird species. You will find a range of flora and fauna in an area comprised of vast open grassland plains, woodlands, rocky outcrops and mountains. The area is bordered in the south by the Dwarsberg Mountains.

The park is roughly 4.5 hours drive from Johannesburg. Safari lodges are mostly located around the eastern and western fringes. The reserve is one-of-a-kind and is known for its involvement in the local communities. Community lodges are owned and run by the local people, creating a healthy economic environment.

Located in the central eastern region of malaria free Madikwe Game Reserve in an area well known for its superior game viewing. Madikwe Safari Lodge consists of 3 separate private lodges (Lelapa, Dithaba and Kopano). The décor is elegant, fresh and contemporary, yet radiating the warmth and vibrant energy of the rich red soil on which it is built. Trees are as much a part of the Lodge's interiors as they are of the untouched bushveld.

All of the suites come with: a private plunge pool, airconditioning and fans, a fireplace, outdoor and indoor shower, personal bar, and the use of a private 4WD safari vehicle.

You will be welcomed at the main lodge into an intimate and unique reception area. There is both an indoor and outdoor dining area for you to enjoy. Relax in the library lounge, indoor lounge with roaring fireplace, or take in some stargazing on the outdoor lounge area and boma.

Daily game drives give you the opportunity to view a wide variety of wildlife species, including the *Big Five*.



IMPODIMO GAME LODGE

Impodimo Game Lodge is 5 star rated by the Tourism Grading Council and located in Madikwe Game Reserve which is malaria free.

The lodge is set along a rocky ridge commanding stunning vistas of the reserve. It is also located at the source of a natural spring, which provides the lodge with elevated views as well as riverine serenity.

The owner/manager team of Steve and Debbie are ideally suited to tailoring the most memorable safari experience. The team has gone to great lengths to ensure guests have as much choice as possible in enjoying their experience. For example, 7-seater Landrovers are used for game drives instead of the traditional 10 seater type.

Impodimo is the first lodge in Madikwe Game Reserve to have qualified Shangaan trackers as part of the team. This adds a different dimension to the safari experience ensuring consistent big game sightings. With fewer guests on the game drive vehicles the team encourages guests to maximise optimal game viewing times.

Daily game drives give you the opportunity to view a wide variety of wildlife species, including the *Big Five*.





VICTORIA FALLS

Victoria Falls presents a spectacular sight of awe-inspiring beauty and grandeur on the Zambezi River, forming the border between Zambia and Zimbabwe. It was described by the Kololo tribe living in the area in the 1800s as Mosi-oa-Tunya – The Smoke that Thunders. Victoria Falls were first sighted by Dr David Livingstone some 150 years ago and this legendary waterfall is known as the greatest curtain of falling water in the world.

Columns of spray can be seen from miles away as, at the height of the rainy season, more than five hundred million cubic metres of water per minute plummet over the edge, over a width of nearly two kilometres, into a gorge over one hundred metres below.

The wide, basalt cliff over which the falls thunder, transforms the Zambezi from a placid river into a ferocious torrent cutting through a series of dramatic gorges.

Facing the falls is another sheer wall of basalt, rising to the same height, and capped by mist-soaked rain forest. A path along the edge of the forest provides the visitor prepared to brave the tremendous spray, with an unparalleled series of views of the falls.

Victoria Falls is a World Heritage listed site where 1,000s of tourists flock each year to see the falls and thrill seekers swim in the Devil's Pool. Thanks to an underwater lip, the pool is on the border of the falls or the Zambia side and accessible during the dry season from August to January.

One special vantage point is across the Knife-edge Bridge, where visitors can have the finest view of the Eastern Cataract and the Main Falls as well as the Boiling Pot, where the river turns and heads down the Batoka Gorge. Other vantage points include the Falls Bridge, Devils Pool and the Lookout Tree, both of which command panoramic views across the Main Falls.

DAVID LIVINGSTONE LODGE

Built overlooking the mighty Zambezi river, the five star David Livingstone Safari Lodge and Spa offers sumptious colonial-styled rooms and is a short drive away from Victoria Falls.

Each of the rooms is luxuriously decorated with four-poster beds draped in mosquito nets. All rooms have a private bathroom and the suites contain a hot tub and lounge area and you can enjoy the sunset from your own private balcony. The lodge has a spa and health club and a private river-cruise boat where you can experience spectacular sunset cruise on the Zambezi or enjoy a host of alternate activities from Elephant rides to Lion walks.

After breakfast, we depart on our flight to Livingstone, Zambia - the gateway to Victoria Falls. Upon arrival, you will be transferred to our accommodation in readiness for the breathtaking beauty of Victoria Falls.

The afternoon is yours to relax before we depart on our Sundowner Zambezi River boat cruise which includes drinks and snacks. Tonight, buffet dinner is included at the lodge.

WED 27 SEP: VICTORIA FALLS + BOMA DINNER

Today you have the opportunity to visit the spectacular and beautiful Victoria Falls. This morning we take a tour around the falls with the afternoon at leisure. Victoria Falls were first sighted by Dr David Livingstone some 150 years ago and this legendary waterfall is amongst the biggest and most awe-inspiring on the planet. The falls generate mist that can be spotted more than 20km away whilst the Zambezi River is more than 2km wide.

Victoria Falls, otherwise known as *Mosi-oa-Tunya*, means the smoke that thunders is a World Heritage listed site where thousands of tourists flock each year to see the falls and thrill seekers swim in the *Devil's Pool*. The pool is formed by an underwater lip that straddles the Zimbabwe/Zambia border and is accessible during the dry season from August to January.

Optional activities are available to purchase from the travel centre at the hotel including fishing or game viewing in the Mosi-oa-Tunya National Park; adrenaline seekers can go abseiling, jet boating, white water rafting or bungee jumping.

The afternoon is at leisure before we meet for a special Boma dinner (included).

THU 28 SEP: FREE DAY OR OPTIONAL TOUR TO CHOBE NATIONAL PARK, BOTSWANA

Today is a free day to do as little or as much as you like. It allows for further exploration and activities in and around Victoria Falls, or you may like to take the full day excursion to Chobe National Park in Botswana. For those wanting to enjoy their natural surrounds, spend the day lying by the infinity

pool on the edge of the Zambezi River, or treat yourself at the luxurious world-class spa the Lodge has to offer. The choice is yours!

This evening, a buffet dinner is included at the lodge as you get to relax and reflect on the day's activities.

SUN 1 OCT: MAD!KWE GAME RESERVE + DUSK GAME DR!VE

This morning we depart for Madikwe Game Reserve where we will be spending the next 2 nights at Madikwe's luxury lodges. Madikwe Game Reserve is the 5th largest game reserve and is also one of South Africa's best kept secrets. This hidden-gem is regarded as one of the best conservation areas in Africa and offers the Big Five in a 680km² park.

It is situated against the Botswana border close to the Kalahari Desert. It is roughly 7 hours by road from Bloemfontein. The game lodges we will be staying in are 5 star rated by the Tourism Grading Council and located in Madikwe Game Reserve which is malaria free.

The *Big Five* is represented in the park and you are likely to spot lion, leopard, elephant, rhino or buffalo during your stay. If you're lucky, you may have the rare privilege of possibly spotting the highly endangered African Wild Dog.







On arrival, you will be treated to lunch before we take a sunset game drive through the park and witness the changing face of its residents as the nocturnal species emerge from their daily slumber.

Overnight: Madikwe Game Reserve - Madikwe Safari Lodge or Impodimo Safari Lodge

MON 2 OCT: SAFARI GAME DRIVES + BOMA DINNER

Rise in the morning to an African dawn and enjoy an early game drive with your dedicated professional ranger in the search for Africa's *Big Five*. Relax as your ranger guides you through the bush on a custom made open Landrover, searching out the plethora of unique native species including giraffe, warthog, kudu, hippo, crocodile, springbok, zebra and wildebeest.

At the conclusion of the drive, we will experience a traditional *Bush Boma* dinner under the stars of the panaromic African sky. The traditional African Boma is nestled within the surrounding bush and is an experience of sheer indulgence as we enjoy a hearty, scrumptious and deliciously different meal under the stars.

TUE 3 OCT: MORNING GAME DRIVE + TRANSFER TO CAPE TOWN-

WED 4 OCT: CAPE TOWN TOUR + TABLE MOUNTAIN CABLE CAR

Following breakfast, we will depart on Cape Town's famous red *Hop On & Hop Off* bus, where you will be able to get your bearings of this beautiful city and explore at your own leisure. There is the obvious drawcard of the V&A Waterfront with all of its shops, bars and restaurants circled by beautiful waters and vast array of boats, but you also have the opportunity to venture a little further and see the stunning coastal suburbs of Camps Bay, Clifton, Sea Point and Green Point.

You may also like to take the cable car to the summit of the famous Table Mountain, which overlooks this incredible city. The floor of the cable car rotates to ensure you get a 360 degree view on the way up and once on top, there are over 2km of pathways that lead to majestic views over Cape Town, Table Bay, Robben Island, Cape Flats, Cape Peninsula and Cape Point National Park. Other sites to visit include the Castle of Good Hope, St George's Cathedral and the District Museum.

For those of you slightly more adventurous, why not purchase the Shark Diving Experience where you will have the opportunity to swim with Cape Town's local Great White Sharks - an adrenalin rushing experience you won't forget!

SAT 7 OCT: ALL BLACKS VS SPRINGBOKS, CAPE TOWN (STADIUM TBC)

Following a leisurely morning, today is your opportunity to spend time shopping through Cape Town. Whether you're looking for handcrafted jewelry, unique arts and crafts, or everyday items, there are plenty of places to shop in Cape Town.

Victoria & Alfred Waterfront: A place to buy almost anything you can think of, the Waterfront in Cape Town has become one of South Africa's most visited destinations. The Waterfront is safe, filled with both unique gift shops and malls with mainstream stores. You can also grab something to eat and watch the boats on the water.

Informal Markets and Stalls: Handmade gifts from local vendors can be great mementos of your trip. Greenmarket Square is one popular place to find small shops with inexpensive and artistic wares. People from South Africa and

neighbouring countries gather at Greenmarket Square and sell everything from hand-painted masks to ostrich eggs to woodcarvings. You can also find pockets of colorful informal markets throughout Cape Town.

When you need a break from shopping, stroll around, listen to the music, and sample some local food.

Soak up the atmosphere at the array of bars and pubs through the V&A Waterfront ready for this afternoon's big match. The Springboks have not taken on the All Blacks in Cape Town since 2008, so the town will be in full gear ready for an exciting night. There will be no love lost as two of rugby's fiercest rivals go into battle in what is sure to be an entertaining match. Kick off is 5pm.



GARDEN ROUTE

The Garden Route is a popular and scenic stretch of the southeastern coast of South Africa. It stretches from Mossel Bay in the Western Cape to the Storms River in the extreme western reach of the neighbouring Eastern Cape.

The name comes from the vibrant and diverse vegetation encountered here and the numerous lagoons and lakes dotted along the coast. The Garden Route includes towns such as Mossel Bay, Knysna, Oudtshoorn, Plettenberg Bay, Nature's Valley and George, the Garden Route's largest city.

It has an oceanic climate, with mild to warm summers, and mild to cool winters. It has the mildest climate in South Africa and the second mildest climate in the world. Temperatures rarely fall below 10°C in winter and rarely climb beyond 28°C in summer.

The Route is sandwiched between the Outeniqua and Tsitsikamma mountains and the Indian Ocean. The surrounding indigenous forests offer hiking trails and eco-tourism activities. Nearly 300 species of bird life are to be found in a variety of habitats ranging from fynbos to forest to wetlands.

Ten nature reserves embrace the varied ecosystems of the area as well as unique marine reserves, home to soft coral reefs, dolphins, seals and a host of other marine life. Various bays along the Garden Route are nurseries to the

endangered Southern Right Whale which go there to calve in the winter and spring (July to December).

Embracing an exquisitely beautiful lagoon and surrounded by ancient forests, Knysna (pronounced *ny-znah*) is probably the most famous town on the Garden Route. It's also home to the country's largest indigenous forest.

OUBAAI GOLF RESORT & SPA

Overlooking Herolds Bay, this upscale golf and spa resort with views of the Outeniqua Mountains is 20km from Gwaing Beach.

Deluxe rooms offer mountain or ocean views from private balconies.

Dining options include a grill eatery with ocean views, a Japanese restaurant and a lounge bar with a fireplace.

Other amenities include 3 bars, a spa, a gym and an outdoor pool, plus an 18-hole golf course.
